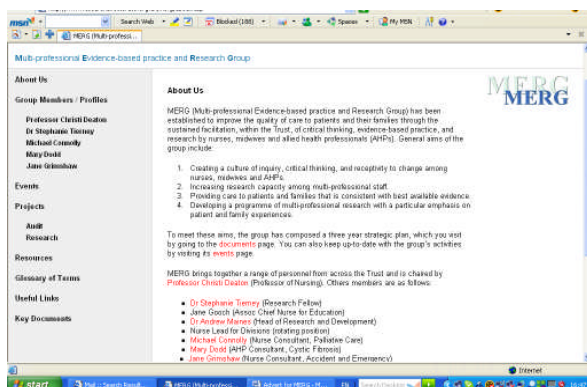


New support for Nurses and Allied Health Professionals
